## WHEN NATURE STRIKES

*Recipe for de-skunking your dog:*

1 quart 3% hydrogen peroxide  
¼ cup baking soda  
1 teaspoon liquid soap (i.e. *Dawn*)

Thoroughly rinse solution from pet's hair with tap water.

**DO NOT CAP SOLUTION.** DO NOT retain excess solution or make the solution in advance; hydrogen peroxide is volatile.
